GOLF GAME DESCRIPTIONS

2 LOW NETS ON ODD; 3 LOW NETS ON EVEN: 2 low nets are used on odd numbered holes per foursome and 3 low nets on even numbered holes are used per foursome.

2 LOW NET SHAMBLE - Everyone drives, choose best ball and play your own ball in from there. 2 low nets per hole per foursome are used.

3 LOW NETS: 3 low nets are used per hole per foursome

3 LOW NET SHAMBLE - Everyone drives, choose best ball and play your own ball in from there. 3 low nets per hole per foursome are used.

LEAST PUTTS: Play your own game and also record putts per hole. Total putts for final score.

STABLEFORD (2 LADY TEAM BEST NET): Play your own game. The best net score of the 2 players is used to obtain points. Net Bogie = 1, Net Par = 2, Net Birdie = 3, Net Eagle = 4.

CAPTAIN VS VICE-CAPTAIN: A fun rivalry game. Captain and Vice-Captain select their teams and advise of play format prior to competition.

CRISERS: Play your own game. Circle the worst 3 holes and change them to Par. Note: for handicap purposes, you must enter the original score in the computer.

CHAPMAN: 2 lady team event. Each person drives then crosses over to their partner's ball. Crossover pattern as follows— 1 x on Par 3 and 4's and 2x on Par 5's. After crossover(s) choose the ball you want to play alternating shots until ball is holed. If Partner A's ball is chosen, partner B takes the next shot.

CRISS/CROSS: Play your own game. Circle the best score between holes 1 & 10, 2 & 11 and so on for a 9 hole score. 1/2 the handicap will be used for scoring. Note: for handicap purposes, you must enter the original score in the computer.

DICE: Throw the dice. If you roll 1, 2,3 or 4 use the score of that player. If you roll a 5 use the best player's score and if you roll a 6 use the worst player's score.

PAR POINTS: Play your own game. Points are awarded as follows: Net Bogey = 1, Net Par = 2, Net Birdie = 3, Net Eagle = 4 & Net Double Eagle = 5.

SCRAMBLE: Everyone drives then choose best ball and plays from there. Choose best ball again and continue to use best ball until ball is holed..

WALTZ: 1 low net is used on 1st hole, 2 low nets on 2nd, 3 low nets on the 3rd. Then the pattern repeats.

REVERSE WALTZ: 3 low nets are used on 1st hole, 2 low nets on 2nd, 1 low net on the 3rd. Then the pattern repeats.
